

Collaborative Collage

Materials:

Magazines or newspapers to cut
Markers, crayons, pencils, and/or paint
Gluesticks
Tape
Plain paper or posterboard (any size)
Some friends
Timer or clock

Gather a small group of friends and have each person take a sheet of plain paper (you can experiment with different sizes).

Set the timer or clock for two to three minutes.

Each person cuts out a single image from a magazine and glues or tapes it to their sheet of paper. When the time is up, they pass their sheet of paper to the person on their right.

Set the time or clock for two to three minutes again.

Each person must now add an additional image, word, or drawing to the piece in front of him or her within the time limit. They then pass the sheet to their right again.

Repeat this process until every person has added something and the work has returned to the original artist.

Try this: if you want to make this more challenging, each time you rotate you can set a specific requirement such as: add something small, add a word, make it mean something, add something about yourself, add something about where you are from, etc.
